RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. All entries will be subject to the general rules and regulations of the Junior Livestock Show.
- 2. Exhibitor must be a Nacogdoches County 4-H, FFA or FCCLA member and continuously attend school in Nacogdoches County or be home schooled and reside within the boundaries of a school district in Nacogdoches County and be at the 12th grade level or below from validation through the end of the show. All entries must be under the care and fed by student from validation until the show.
- 3. All market goats must have been validated by June 20, 2015 as per show rules. Exhibitors may validate multiple animals. Only one goat per exhibitor may be brought to show grounds.
- 4. This division is open to wether goats only.
- 5. All market goats must be dehorned or have horn tipped prior to weigh in at show. Ends of tipped horns must be larger than a dime in diameter.
- 6. All market goats must be slick shorn to the skin above knees and hock joints prior to entering the show for judging.
- 7. WEIGHT LIMIT: Market goats must weigh a minimum of 50 lbs. and cannot weigh more than 130 lbs. (with a five pound tolerance)
- CLASSES: Market goats will be divided into classes as evenly as possible by weight immediately 8. after the official weigh-in.
- 9. All entries except goats selected for Premium Sale will be released immediately following the show.
- Showmanship will be a jackpot with a \$5.00 entry fee and pay two places for Junior and Senior 10. Division. Showmanship Divisions will be: 13 and under - Junior

(Ages are as of the day of show)

14 and over - Senior

Pee Wee Showmanship - No entry fee

(5-8 years old and not entered in this show)

Each exhibitor must exhibit his/her entry in showmanship classes, pee wee must use a goat exhibited in the show.

- 11. Showmanship will begin immediately following the selection of Grand and Reserve Champions and sale order. The Premium Sale will be held Saturday, October 10, 2015 at 6:00 P.M.
- 12. Goats will be disgualified for (a) a non-legible tattoo (b) description of goat differs from validation form (c) failure to provide proper documentation and signature of validation form.
