## **RULES & REGULATIONS**

1. All Piney Woods Fair Livestock Show general rules and regulations apply to the Lamb Show.

- 2. Exhibitor must be a Nacogdoches County 4-H, FFA or FCCLA member and continuously attend school in Nacogdoches County or be home schooled and reside within the boundaries of a school district in Nacogdoches County and be at the 12<sup>th</sup> grade level or below from validation through the end of the show. All entries must be under the care and fed by student from validation until the show.
- 3. Lambs must be owned and validated on June 21, 2014.
- 4. Any breed or cross, wether, will be allowed to show. Only one lamb per exhibitor may be brought to the show grounds.
- 5. Lambs weighing less than 100 lbs. or more than 150 lbs (with a 5 lb tolerance) at show weigh-in will be sifted. Sifted lambs must be removed from the grounds after weigh in.
- 6. Lambs must be shorn no more than 5 days prior to show with coat no longer than  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch long at show. (slick shorn)
- 7. Classes will be broken by weight and posted following the weigh in.
- 8. Showmanship will be a jackpot with a \$5.00 entry fee and pay two places for Junior and Senior

Division. Showmanship Divisions will be: 13 and under - Junior

(Ages are as of the day of show) 14 and over - Senior

Pee Wee Showmanship - No entry fee

(5-8 years old and not entered in this show)

Each exhibitor must exhibit his/her entry in showmanship classes, pee wee must use a lamb exhibited in the show.

- 9. Contestants must be able to maintain control of their animal at all times in and out of show ring.
- 10. No altering of hair coat, by paint, powder or artificial coloring. No top knots on head.
- 11. Shavings may be purchased from the Expo Center
- 12. Showmanship begins at 1 p.m., Friday, followed by judging and concluding with the selection of Grand and Reserve Champions followed by sale order selection. The Premium Sale will be held Saturday, October 11, 2014, 6:00 P.M.
- 13. Lambs will be disqualified for (a) non-legible tattoo (b) description of lamb differs from validation form (c) failure to provide documentation and signature of validation form.
