RULES & REGULATIONS

1. All entries will be subject to the general rules and regulations of the Junior Livestock Show.
2. Exhibitor must be a 4-H, FFA or FCCLA member and continuously attend school in Nacogdoches County or be home schooled and reside within the boundaries of a school district in Nacogdoches County and be at the 12th grade level or below from validation through the end of the show. Students must be able to take rabbits to the judging area without assistance from adults. All entries must be under the care and fed by student from validation until the show.
3. This is a carrier show and all animals must be in a solid bottom, leak proof carrier.
4. **All market rabbit entries must attend validation on Thursday, September 5, 2013 at the Civic Center, 4:00 - 6:00 P.M. and receive an ear validation tag in order to be eligible to exhibit in the 2013 Piney Woods Fair.**
5. Disqualifications include: ear canker, sore hocks, buck teeth and any other obvious disease. Any sick animals will be removed from the show at the discretion of the committee.
6. A pen will be three (3) rabbits of either sex, all the same breed and variety, not weigh less than 3 lbs. or more than 5 lbs. for each rabbit, one ounce allowance per rabbit. No Substitutions.
7. Judging will begin immediately after the Jr. Breeding Rabbit Show, concluding with the selection of Grand and Reserve Champions, followed by sale order selection. The Premium Sale will be held Saturday, October 12, 2013 at 6 P.M.
8. Market animals selected for drug test must complete test before leaving the fairgrounds on Tuesday, October 8th.
9. The decision of the judge will be final.
