RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1) This show is open to all residents of East Texas.
- 2) All entries must be in clean, polished STANDARD MASON glass canning jars. Lids must be scaled and free from rust and corrosion. Entries not compliant with these standards will not be allowed in competition.
- 3) Jars must be clearly labeled with the name of the product and the exhibitor's name, address, and phone number before they are accepted into the competition.
- 4) All entries must have been completed by the Exhibitor within twelve (12) months prior to the Piney Woods Fair.
- 5) Three (3) entries may be made in each category per exhibitor.
- 6) Judges may award a 1st Place in a category even if the category has no other entries for competition in that category. In the event of a tie, the Judges decision is final.
- 7) All entries will be released for pick up on Sunday, October 15, 2023 between the hours of 3:00 P.M. and 4:00 P.M. only. Entries not retrieved by 5:00 P.M. on Monday, October 16, 2023 will be discarded. Although great care is taken with all entries, the Pineywoods Fair is not responsible for loss or damage to entries left after the conclusion of the Fair.

First (1st) through Third (3rd) Place ribbons will be awarded in Junior and Senior Divisions of each category.

Participation Ribbons will be awarded for Junior Division only.

Best of Show Rosettes will be awarded in Junior, Senior, and Adult Divisions

The point system is as follows: Blue Ribbon = 3 points, Red Ribbon = 2 points, White Ribbon = 1 point,

Best of Category = 2 points.
