In order to participate in the Piney Woods Fair Youth Ambassador Program, you will need to have the permission slip signed by your school Guidance Counselor and a parent or guardian. We ask that participating students commit to no less than 2 shifts.

Youth Ambassador duties include but are not limited to:

Assisting vendors, answer questions that our guests may have about the fair schedule, keep assigned areas clean and free of trash, and restock and tidy restrooms.

Service hours will be 6:00pm - 9:00pm Wednesday - Friday

11:00am - 3:00pm & 6:00pm - 9:00pm Saturday

1:00pm - 5:00pm Sunday

We will have a total of 24 positions available to fill 9 stations per shift. You will receive an admission pass, name badge, and official Youth Ambassador t-shirt. The name badge and official t-shirt must be worn for the duration of your shift. To receive credit for your service hours you must sign in and sign out in the Civic Center Office. Lockers are available to store your personal belongings during your shift.

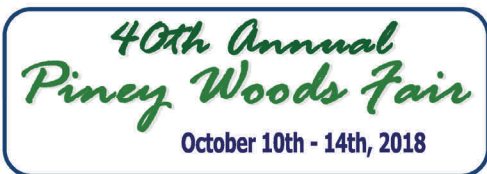
You will need to have your own transportation to and from the Fairgrounds.

We suggest you wear comfortable shoes, bring a water bottle (Ice and water will be available in the Civic Center), and bring cash for meals and personal expenditures.

We also ask that you keep your cell phones securely concealed during your shift.

At the conclusion of the fair you will receive a letter and certificate verifying service hours worked to accompany your college application.

Youth Ambassadors are High School students currently enrolled in Nacogdoches County. Youth Ambassadors represent the purpose of the Piney Woods Fair; which is to further students interest and knowledge in agriculture while developing character through personal responsibility. Students participating in the Youth Ambassador program will receive a letter and certificate verifying their hours of volunteer work to accompany their college applications, 8 Free Ride Passes (Sponsored by Evans United Shows), and a Piney Woods Youth Ambassador T-Shirt (Sponsored by Armadillo Signs) to wear while on duty.

Duties will include but are not limited to: Assisting vendors, provide our guests with information about the fair, keep assigned areas free of trash and debris, and restock and tidy restrooms. Since most shifts are on school nights none will begin sooner than 6:00pm and last no later than 9:00pm. We suggest that students wear comfortable shoes, bring a water bottle to stay hydrated (ice and water available for them in the Civic Center), and bring cash for meals and personal expenditures.

YOUTH AMBASSADOR CODE OF CONDUCT & PROCEDURES

- 1) Please remember that this is a family friendly event and conduct yourself accordingly.
- 2) Sign in and out for each shift in the Civic Center Office located inside the lobby of the Civic Center to receive credit for hours worked.
- 3) You will receive one Day Pass for each shift you are assigned in order to gain admission to the fairgrounds. You will receive your ride passes at the end of your shift.
- 4) Keep your cell phone securely concealed during your shift.
- 5) Report any problems to the Civic Center Office or Security/EMS Office located in front of Barn 1.
- 6) Do not engage in any behavior which might cause harm to yourself or others.
- 7) Be aware that while wearing your Youth Ambassador shirt you are representing the Piney Woods Fair, your school, and yourself. Have pride in your appearance and behavior.
