Important Information:

Based on the current COVID-19 restrictions, constraints, and orders, the Piney Woods Fair Livestock Shows cannot be held in typical format of past shows. The following format was approved by our Nacogdoches County and City officials and will be implemented for the 2020 Piney Woods Fair.

- There will be no overnight housing of animals. All arrive, show, and release on set day.
- Exhibitors will receive pass for themselves and two (2) additional passes for family.
- Passes will be in the form of an armband, color-coded by the day and the livestock show. Only individual with appropriate armbands will be allowed on the Expo grounds for that show being held on that day.
- Only one secure, drive-through gate for entry and departure.
- Exhibitors will be required to wear face covering while exhibiting their livestock in the show ring.
- Face coverings and social distancing will be required in order to comply with the Governor's Executive Order.
- No animals (including Grand or Reserve) will be brought to the Premium Sale.
- During Premium Sale, all chairs on Main Arena floor are reserved for buyers. Exhibitors not in the ring and all parents must sit in the stands. Face coverings and social distancing will be required in order to comply with the Governor's Executive Order.
