The Youth Ambassador program gives college-bound seniors the opportunity to obtain service hours for their college application. Youth Ambassadors will have several duties during the fair operating hours. Duties include but are not limited to: Assist Vendors, answer questions that our guests have about the fair, keep assigned areas clean and free of trash, and restock and tidy restrooms.

In exchange for their volunteer hours they will receive a certificate and letter confirming their service hours, a parking pass to gain entrance to the fairgrounds at no charge, 8 free ride passes sponsored by Evans United Shows, and a Piney Woods Fair Youth Ambassador t-shirt to be worn during performance of service hours.

Service hours will be: 6:00 PM - 9:00 PM Wednesday - Friday

11:00 AM - 3:00 PM & 6:00 PM - 9:00 PM Saturday

1:00 PM - 5:00 PM Sunday

(must sign in and out at the Civic Center Office)

There are a total of 24 positions available to 9 volunteers per shift, and volunteers may work as many shifts as they wish to sign up for. Volunteers must have a permission slip signed by their parent or guardian and provide their own transportation to and from the fairgrounds. Meals are not provided so please bring cash for personal expenditures. We suggest that volunteers wear comfortable shoes and bring a water bottle.

Permission Slip for Youth Ambassadors

Youth Ambassadors are High School students currently enrolled in Nacogdoches County. The function of the Youth Ambassador is to represent the purpose of the Pineywoods Fair, which is to further students' knowledge and interest in agriculture while developing personal responsibility. Students participating in the Youth Ambassador program will receive a certificate for their hours of volunteer work to accompany their college applications, 8 Free Ride Passes (Sponsored by Evans United Shows), and a Pineywoods Youth Ambassador T-Shirt (Sponsored by Armadillo Signs) to wear while on duty.

Duties will include but are not limited to: Assisting Vendors, provide our guests with information about the fair, keep assigned areas free of trash and debris, and restock and tidy restrooms. Since most shifts are on school nights, none will begin sooner than 6:00pm and last no later than 9:00pm. We suggest that students wear comfortable shoes, bring a water bottle to stay hydrated (ice and water available for them in the Civic Center), and bring cash for meals and personal expenditures.

Code of Conduct and Procedures

- 1) Please remember that this is a family friendly event and conduct yourself accordingly.
- 2) Sign in and out for each shift in the Civic Center Office located inside the lobby of the Civic Center. If you are unable to arrive for your shift please call or text Anita Scott at (936) 462-0426.
- 3) You will receive one Day Pass for each shift you are assigned in order to gain admission to the fairgrounds. You will receive your ride passes at the end of your shift.
- 4) Keep your cell phone securely concealed during your shift.
- 5) Report any problems to the Civic Center Office or Security/EMS Office located in front of Barn 1.
- 6) Do not engage in any behavior which might cause harm to yourself or others.
- 7) Be aware that while wearing your Youth Ambassador shirt you are representing the Pineywoods Fair, your school, and yourself. Have pride in your appearance and behavior.
