RULES & REGULATIONS

- All entries will be subject to the General Rules & Regulations of the Junior Livestock Show.
- 2) Exhibitor must be a bona fide Nacogdoches County 4-H, Jr. FFA, or FFA member, be continuously enrolled in or entering the 3rd through 12th grade of a public K12 or private school in Nacogdoches County, from the required date of validation through the conclusion of either the PWF or NCSS; or, be home schooled and reside within the boundaries of a Nacogdoches County school district and e continuously enrolled in or entering the 3rd through the 12th grade from the required date of validation through the conclusion of either the PWF or NCSS.
- 3) Any breed wether lamb, will be allowed to show.
- 4) All entries must be under the care of and fed by the exhibitor from validation through the end of the show. Exhibitor must maintain control of their animal at all times in and out of the show ring.
- 5) All lambs must have been validated on Saturday, June 24, 2023 at the Nacogdoches County Expo between 6:00 9:00 am AS PER SHOW RULES. Exhibitors may validate multiple animals; however, only one (1) lamb per exhibitor may be brought to the show grounds.
- 6) No altering of hair coat by paint, powder, artificial coloring, or adhesive will be prohibited.
- 7) No top knots on head.
- 8) Exhibitors are responsible for turning in weight card by 5:00 pm on Thursday, October 12, 2023. Validation forms will be checked on Thursday, October 12, 2023 from 4:00 5:00 pm. Lambs must weigh between 100 170 lbs. They will be sifted by weight and classes will be divided as evenly as possible by weight.
- 9) All class winners will be subject to a weigh back. Any lamb weighing more then 5 lbs over official weigh in weight will be allowed to weigh one addition time before being disqualified.
- 10) Judging begins at 9:00 am on Friday, October 13, 2023 concluding with the selection of Grand & Reserve Champions followed by the sale order selection of class winners and other remaining placing premium sale lambs. Showmanship will follow the conclusion of the premium sale selection. All lambs will be released at the conclusion of the show.
- 11) Showmanship Divisions (Ages are as of the day of the show):

Junior: 13 years and Under Senior: 14 years and Over

Pee Wee: 8 years and Under and not entered in this show

Each exhibitor must exhibit his/her entry in Showmanship Classes, Pee Wee must use a goat exhibited in the show.

- 12) The Premium Sale will be held Saturday, October 14, 2023 at 6:00 pm. Grand and Reserve Champion lambs ONLY will need to be present for the premium sale. All other lots will be the exhibitor only.
- 13) A market resale will not be held; each exhibitor is responsible for the resale of their animal and for the care of their animal until it reaches final destination. All animals must be removed from fairgrounds by noon Sunday, October 15th.
- 14) Market animals selected for a drug test must complete the test immediately following the sale order selection on Friday, October 13, 2023.
- 15) Shavings must be purchased from the Nacogdoches County Expo Center. No other type of bedding will be allowed.
- 16) Lambs will be disqualified for: a) a non-legible tattoo, b) description of lamb differs from validation form, c) exhibitor fails to provide proper documentation and signatures on validation form.
