

## Permission Slip for Youth Ambassadors

Youth Ambassadors are High School students currently enrolled in Nacogdoches County. The purpose of the Nacogdoches Pro Rodeo Youth Ambassador program is to further students knowledge and interest in rodeo and agriculture while developing personal responsibility. Students participating in the Youth Ambassador program will receive a certificate for their hours of volunteer work to accompany their college applications and receive a Nacogdoches Pro Rodeo Youth Ambassador T-Shirt (Sponsored by Armadillo Signs) to wear while on duty. These t-shirts will be theirs to keep.

Duties will include but are not limited to: Assisting Vendors, provide our guests with information about the rodeo, operate video camera, take tickets, keep assigned areas free of trash and debris, and restock and tidy restrooms. The shifts will begin at 5:45 pm and end at 9:45pm each night. We suggest that students wear comfortable shoes, bring a water bottle to stay hydrated (ice and water available for them in the Civic Center) and bring cash for snacks and personal expenditures. Raising Cane's & Pizza Hut will supply a meal and a drink from for our YA's each night.

## Code of Conduct and Procedures

- Sign in and out at the end shift in the Civic Center Office located inside the lobby of the Civic Center. 2)

- 7) Be aware that while wearing your Youth Ambassador shirt you are representing the Nacogdoches Pro Rodeo, your school, and yourself. Have pride in your appearance and behavior.
