## RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1) All entries will be subject to the General Rules & Regulations of the Junior Livestock Show.
- 2) Exhibitor must be a Nacogdoches County 4-H, FFA, and/or FCCLA member and continuously attend school in Nacogdoches County or be home schooled and reside within the boundaries of a school district in Nacogdoches County; and be at the 12th grade level or below from validation through the end of the show.
- 3) This class is open to Wether goats only.
- 4) All entries must be under the care of and fed by the exhibitor from validation through the end of the show. Exhibitor must maintain control of their animal at all times in and out of the show ring.
- 5) All goats must have been validated on Saturday, June 25, 2022 at the Nacogdoches County Expo between 6:00 A.M. to 9:00 A.M. AS PER SHOW RULES. Exhibitors may validate multiple animals; however, only (1) goat per exhibitor may be brought to the show grounds.
- 6) All Market Goats must be dehorned or have horn tipped prior to weigh in at show. Ends of tipped horns must be larger than a dime in diameter.
- 7) All Market Goats must be sheared above the knees and hock joints prior to entering the show for judging.
- 8) Exhibitors are responsible for turning in **weight card by 5:00 PM on Thursday Oct 13, 2022**. Validation forms will be checked on Thursday, October 13, 2022 from 4:00 P.M. till 5:00 P.M. Goats must weigh between 50 lbs to 130 lbs. They will be sifted by weight and classes will be divided as evenly as possible by weight.
- 9) A minimum of four (4) top placing Goats in each class will be subject to a weigh back Any Goat weighing more then 5 lbs over official weigh in weight will be allowed to weigh one addition time before being disqualified.
- 10) Showmanship will be a jackpot with a \$5.00 entry fee. Paying 2 places per Junior & Senior Divisions (60-40 split per division. Showmanship Divisions: 13 and Under - Junior (Ages are as of the day of the show)  
14 and Over - Senior  
Pee Wee Showmanship - No entry fee (5-8 years old and not entered in this show  
Each exhibitor must exhibit his/her entry in Showmanship Classes, Pee Wee must use a goat exhibited in the show.
- 11) Judging will begin immediately after Showmanship, followed by the selection of Grand & Reserve Champions and sale order. The Premium Sale will be held Saturday, October 15, 2022 at 6:00 P.M.
- 12) Shavings must be purchased from the Nacogdoches County Expo Center. No other type of bedding will be allowed.
- 13) Goats will be disqualified for: a) a non-legible tattoo, b) description of goat differs from validation form, c) exhibitor fails to provide proper documentation and signatures on validation form.
