## **RULES & REGULATIONS**

- 1) All entries will be subject to the General Rules & Regulations of the Junior Livestock Show.
- 2) Exhibitor must be a Nacogdoches County 4-H, FFA, and/or FCCLA member and continuously attend school in Nacogdoches County or be home schooled and reside within the boundaries of a school district in Nacogdoches County; and be at the 12th grade level or below from validation through the end of the show.
- 3) Any breed, cross or wether, will be allowed to show. Only one (1) lamb per exhibitor may be brought to the show grounds.
- 4) All entries must be under the care of and fed by the exhibitor from validation through the end of the show. Exhibitor must maintain control of their animal at all times in and out of the show ring.
- 5) All lambs must have been validated on Saturday, June 20, 2020 at the Nacogdoches County Expo between 6:00 A.M. 9:00 A.M. AS PER SHOW RULES. Exhibitors may validate multiple animals; however, only one (1) lamb per exhibitor may be brought to the show grounds.
- 6) Exhibitors are responsible for turning in weight card by 5:00 PM on Thursday Oct 8, 2020. Validation forms will be checked on Thursday, October 8, 2020 from 4:00 P.M. till 5:00 P.M. Lambs must weigh between 100 lbs to 150 lbs. They will be sifted by weight and classes will be divided as evenly as possible by weight.
- 7) All Market Lambs must be slick shorn no more than 5 days prior to the show with a coat no longer than 1/4 inch at show. No altering of hair coat by paint, powder, or artificial coloring. No top knots on head and no adhesive may be used.
- 8) A minimum of four (4) top placing Lambs in each class will be subject to a weigh back. Any Lamb weighing more then 5 lbs over official weigh in weight will be allowed to weigh one addition time before being disqualified.
- 9) Showmanship will be a jackpot with a \$5.00 CASH entry fee. Paying 2 places per Junior & Senior Divisions (60-40 split per division).

Showmanship Divisions: 13 and Under - Junior (Ages are as of the day of the show)

14 and Over - Senior

Pee Wee Showmanship - No entry fee (7 years old or younger and not entered in this show)

Each exhibitor must exhibit his/her entry in Showmanship Classes, Pee Wee must use a lamb exhibited in the show.

- 10) Showmanship will begin at 1:00 P.M., Friday, October 9, 2020, followed by judging, and concluding with the selection of the Grand & Reserve Champions and sale order. The Premium Sale will be held Saturday, October 10, 2020 at 6:00 P.M.
- 11) Shavings must be purchased from the Nacogdoches County Expo Center. No other type of bedding will be allowed.
- 12) Lambs will be disqualified for: a) a non-legible tattoo, b) description of lamb differs from validation form, c) exhibitor fails to provide proper documentation and signatures on validation form.
