RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1)  Exhibitor must be a bona fide Nacogdoches County 4-H, Jr. FFA, or FFA member, be continuously enrolled in or entering the 3rd through 12th grade of a public K12 or private school in Nacogdoches County, from the required date of validation through the conclusion of either the PWF or NCSS; or, be home schooled and reside within the boundaries of a Nacogdoches County school district and be continuously enrolled in or entering the 3rd through the 12th grade from the required date of validation through the conclusion of either the PWF or NCSS.
- 2) Entries previously submitted in the Pineywoods Fair Project Show are not eligible, including but not limited to entries including additions and/or revisions of previously entered projects and new projects that include major parts from previously entered projects. If it is additions and/or revisions of previously entered projects, it must be shown as in the Restoration-Repurpose Division.
- 3) All entries must have been completed after the 2022 Pineywoods Fair. All entries must be certified and under supervision of Ag Teacher or County Extension Agent prior to the show. **Entries must be submitted by the Ag Teacher or Extension Agent by Friday, October 6, 2023 to the Ag Mech Division Chairman.**
- 4) There will be eight (8) Divisions in which projects may be entered:
 - A) Livestock Equipment
 - B) Agricultural/Shop Machinery/Equipment
 - C) Home and Yard - Metal (Any project which contains structural metal framework)
 - D) Home and Yard- Wood (Must be built completely out of wood other than décor/brackets/hinges)
 - E) BBQ Pits and Smokers
 - F) Wildlife
 - G) Trailers - Single Axle, Tandem Axle
 - H) Restoration - Repurpose
- 5) Projects will be judged on points:

A) Workmanship	30	D) Practical Utility	15
B) Sound Structural Design & Balance	25	E) Originality	5
C) Degree of Difficulty	20	F) Appropriate Finish	5
- 6) If the project is for sale a minimum price must be exhibited.
- 7)  Projects will be placed in each division 1st - 10th Place. All placing items will be sold at auction Saturday, October 14, 2023 at 2:00 pm. 1st place banners will be awarded in each division at the beginning of the auction on Saturday. Blue, Red, and White ribbons will be awarded to all other exhibitors entered at the completion of judging. In case of a tie, the judge will make the final tie-breaking decision. The judges decision is final. Any project not placing that wants to sell may be sold through the silent auction only.
- 8) All Sale Eligible projects must remain on the grounds until the conclusion of the Ag Mechanics Auction on Saturday. **All non-sale projects may be retrieved from 12 - 2 pm on Friday or 9 - 12 pm on Saturday.** Any projects that leaves prior to this will forfeit all placings and/or sweepstakes points for that entry. Grand and Reserve Overall Projects will be selected using a two judge panel.

--SWEEPSTAKES AWARD--

A Sweepstakes Award will be given to the FFA Chapter or 4-H Group scoring the most points. Determination of the Sweepstakes Winner will be made by the following formula:

	1st Place: Ten (10) points	2nd Place: Nine (9) points	3rd Place: Eight (8) points	4th Place: Seven (7) points
	5th Place: Six (6) points	6th Place: Five (5) points	7th Place: Four (4) points	8th place: Three (3) points
	9th Place: Two (2) points	10th Place: One (1) point		

Grand Champion Overall: Ten (10) additional points

Reserve Champion Overall: Five (5) additional points

***Total points will be added, then divided by the total number of projects placed plus one. The Chapter or Club with the highest score will be the Sweepstakes Winner. You must enter one project in at least five (5) of the eight (8) divisions to be eligible for the Sweepstakes Award.
