RULES & REGULATIONS

- This division is open to all residents of East Texas. Exhibitors must be amateur photographers. Judgment of status will be made by the Chairman.
- <u>ALL ENTRIES MUST BE 8" X 10" AND MOUNTED ON AN 11" X 14" MOUNTING BOARD.</u> 11" x 14" mounting boards available at Hobby Lobby and Walmart and can be ordered online. We suggest you acquire your mounting boards early to ensure availability and avoid store outages. Odd size prints or boards will not be accepted in the competition.
- PRINTS CAN NOT BE FRAMED OR UNDER GLASS. Plastic covering will be permitted.
- Photos entered may be color or black & white; however, both will be judged together in the same category.
- Exhibitors may enter up to four (4) prints, with no more than two (2) prints per category.
- All entries must have been photographed by Exhibitor within twelve (12) months prior to the Piney Woods Fair.
- Entries that have previously been submitted at the Piney Woods Fair or any other previous competition are not eligible.
- All entries will be released for pick up on Sunday, October 16, 2022 between the hours of 3:00 P.M. and 4:00 P.M. only. Entries not retrieved by 5:00 P.M. on Monday, October 17, 2022 will be forfeit. Although great care is taken with all entries, the Pineywoods Fair is not responsible for loss or damage to abandoned entries left at the conclusion of the Fair.
